

# McCurdy Plantation Horse Registry

## Rules of Appendix Registration

Revised February 8, 2021

1. A horse which has one full McCurdy Plantation Horse registered parent, and which meets item 2 and all other requirements below, may be eligible for registration, subject to the following requirements. Such horse will be referred to in the Stud Book and on the Registration Certificate as Appendix Registered and acknowledged with an "A" before the registration number.

2. **A Full Registered McCurdy Plantation Horse X Registered Gaited Breed**

Offspring of a full Registered McCurdy parent and a Registered Gaited Breed parent may be Appendix Registered as a McCurdy upon completion and submission of an application and a copy of the registration papers on the non-McCurdy registered parent and meeting the below requirements. The non-McCurdy registered parent must also be true to the below colors historical to the McCurdy Breed.

**Registered Gaited Breeds** means only the following breeds:

Tennessee Walking Horse	American Saddlebred
Missouri Foxtrotter	Mountain Pleasure
Racking Horse	

3. Candidates for Appendix registration, as well as the non-McCurdy registered parent, must be either gray or be primarily of a solid color historically characteristic of McCurdy-bred horses, e.g., black, bay, chestnut, sorrel or roan (Bay, Red, Blue, Black).
4. Color photographs showing front and both side views of the candidate for registration must be attached to the application.
5. Candidates for Appendix registration may be subject to inspection by a Registry official.
6. Horses which are  $\frac{3}{4}$  or higher blood lineage McCurdy may be pedigree registered as a McCurdy Plantation Horse (example—offspring of a full registered McCurdy parent X Appendix registered McCurdy may be pedigree registered).
7. Examples of offspring registration of Appendix registered horses:
  - Offspring of Appendix registered McCurdy (50%) X full registered McCurdy (100%) (Pedigree or Foundation) **will be eligible** for pedigree registration. Foal will be 75% McCurdy and considered fully Pedigree Registered.
  - Offspring of Appendix registered McCurdy (50%) X Appendix registered McCurdy (50%) **will not be eligible** for pedigree registration. It may, however, be considered for Foundation Registration.
